

## What you'll need

- Your NetID and Active Directory password (or, for guests, a guest ID and guest password)
- A wireless card that supports WPA2 and 802.11 a/b/g (older wireless cards don't always provide WPA2 support)
- IllinoisNet wireless signal with good or excellent signal strength

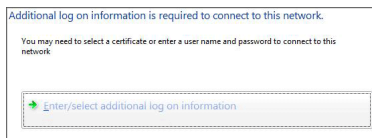

## Getting connected

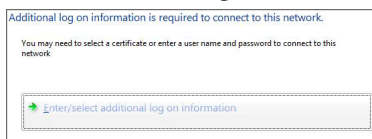
1. Go to the **Start** menu -> **Connect To** -> **IllinoisNet**, then choose "Enter/select additional log on information."



2. Log in with your NetID and Active Directory password (or your guest ID and password)

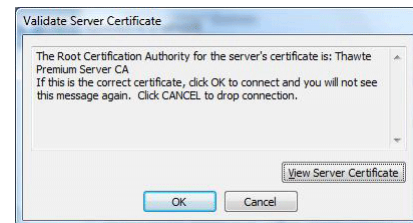


3. "Enter/select additional log on information" again.

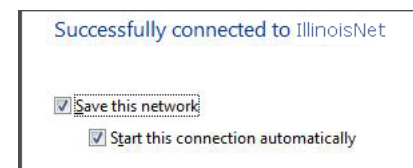


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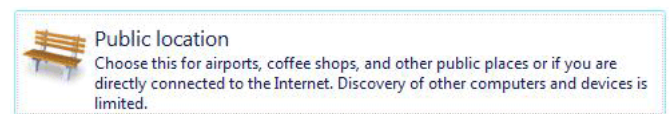
4. OK the Thawte or AddTrust server certificate.



5. You should see a "successful connection" notice.
- If this is *your* laptop and you always use it on campus, you can leave all the boxes checked.
  - If this is a *shared* or *lab* laptop, or if it's usually off campus, uncheck the boxes.



6. If asked for a network location, select "public location."



Now you're connected to the IllinoisNet wireless service.
